

Notification of scholarships (Deutschlandstipendium) to be awarded at the FIT Hermansburg

The University of Applied Sciences for Intercultural Theology Hermansburg (FIT) is expecting to award one scholarship (Deutschlandstipendium) for the winter semester 2020/21.

All students officially registered at FIT Hermansburg can apply for the scholarship. The Deutschlandstipendium is awarded to academically talented students, who are socially committed and involved in university student organizations.

A Deutschlandstipendium is a grant of **300,00 € per month** (irrespective of income or whether BAföG has been granted or not). Initially the grant is awarded for **one year**, i.e. from October 2020 to September 2021. Students, who are already recipients of a high achievement-oriented scholarship or students, who have exceeded the prescribed period of study, will not be considered.

The application deadline is Friday, 7th of August 2020.

The following application documents must be submitted:

1. The application form, completed and signed, as well as a letter detailing your eligibility
2. CV in tabular form
3. Relevant academic certificates, which have previously not been submitted to FIT
4. Verification of other grants received (e.g other high achievement-oriented grants etc).

Selection procedure and criteria:

The FIT university governance appoints a committee to select the scholarship recipient. Stipulated selection criteria, according to the federal regulations for scholarships (STipG) and the rules and regulations (StipV) of the scholarship programme, are:

1. Outstanding academic performance
2. Exceptional social commitment and involvement in university organizations
3. The student's personal circumstances and challenges.

No student is legally entitled to be a recipient of the Deutschlandstipendium.

The scholarship is awarded subject to the financial resources available.
